## **Sound System**

The sound system has the following capabilities:

- Hand held and headset/clip-on microphones which can operate at the same time.
- 2. Wired microphone with connections at the front and rear of the Hall.
- 3. Built-in CD player.
- 4. Bluetooth connection for phone or iPAD, for playing music etc.
- 5. Phono sockets (L&R) and a 3.5mm jack socket for sound system connection.
- 6. USB stick connection for music.
- 7. Connection to the Hall Clavinova.
- 8. There is a small mixer for all the above in the front-of-stage box.

In addition, a large mixer is available for connection at the rear of the Hall to control all the above, plus stage box connections. A bass speaker can be connected to the system and is controlled separately.

## **Projector**

The projection system has the following capabilities:

- 1. HD projector with 4m screen.
- 2. Built-in BluRay player for playing BluRay or DVD discs. Please note that it will not play HD-DVDs. It can also play slides from a USB stick.
- 3. HDMI connections for a laptop computer are available both at the front and rear of the Hall. Whatever you show on the computer screen will be projected onto the screen. The HDMI also connects to the sound system for playing videos with sound.
- 4. It is up to the user to ensure that his computer has a suitable HDMI port to connect to the projection system. Various conversion devices are available in the Hall to convert signals to HDMI, but it is the user's responsibility to ensure that a suitable one is available if required.
